Project description

The economic crisis has led to an increase in the gap between labour supply and demand (**youth unemployment** in the EU in 2012 was **22.7%** - Eurostat).

The gap is even more significant for **NEETS** (**22,7%** in Italy-*EuroFound 2015*) and **vulnerable youth** (*2008 CEDEFOP, Building on Skills Forecasts*) due to:

- low effectiveness and poor relevance of Active Labour Market Policies;
 - the low capacity of Public Employment Centres and Vocational Training to intercept young people at risk and to give a concrete response to their needs and promote their professionalism.

Project description

- poor synergy between public and private actors and of an integrated strategy to facilitate the transition of young people into the labour market;
- the little knowledge of young people about services provided by employment services, intensified by poor information and communication between providers
- lack of involvement of beneficiary in his/her orientation, learning, job placement process: *“there is a need to give individuals the opportunity to develop their own learning, also tailoring ICT tools to facilitate their transition to work (2010 EC - A new impetus for EU cooperation in VET).*



Overall Objective:

- To foster inclusive education, training and youth employability in Europe through an enhanced access to training, and to more efficient and integrated guidance, public and private employment services particularly by disadvantaged youth.

Specific objectives:

- To strengthen the awareness and access to more integrated and effective active employment by young job-seekers and disadvantaged learners aged 18-29 in Europe.

Operational objectives:

- **To develop learner-centered game-based e-solutions** to raise youth awareness on ALMPs measures, and attract in particular NEETs and vulnerable youth.
- **To increase cross-sectoral cooperation among VET, employment and guidance** in education to deliver skills assessment, counselling, and qualification through “tailored services”.
- **To mainstream** in formal and non-formal settings (VET, education, youth work, public-private JPOs) **e-services guidance**, integrating them into the JOB Labyrinth game and Community of Practices to enable beneficiaries’ skills as active job seekers.
- **To develop and disseminate guidelines** to build the capacities of EU actors on how to use e-tools and enable clients to access services and information.

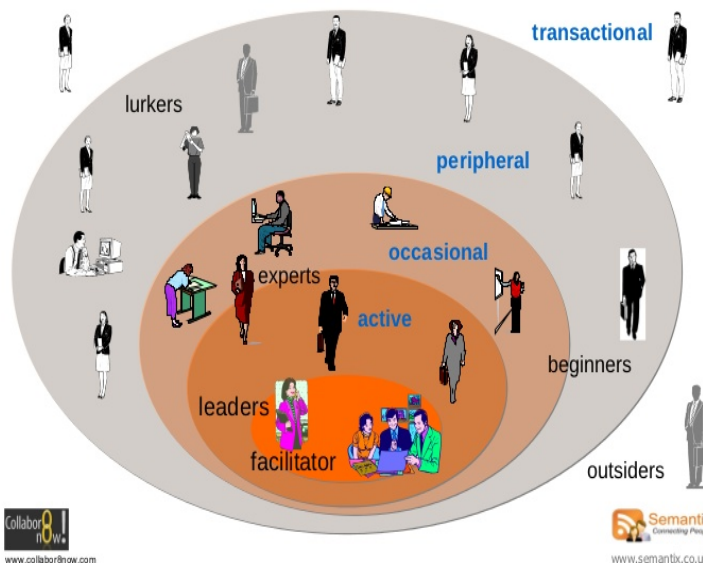
